Pastor Shon shared this story with me today and it was so powerful that I thought I would share it with all of you.

The Man Who Just Couldn't Let Go

There once was a man who enjoyed the challenge of climbing very steep mountains. This man who we will call Walls went mountain climbing as often as he could. Walls loved the outdoors and he loved taking pictures of all the wildlife.

Walls was climbing down when suddenly a very thick fog came rolling in. The fog was so thick that poor Walls could not see how far he still had to climb to reach the ground and to make matters worse it began getting very cold.
