JOHN 4:1-26 CHRIST YESHUA WITNESSES TO THE WOMAN BY THE WELL

Therefore, when the Lord knew that the Pharisees had heard that Yeshua made and baptized more disciples than John. Though Yeshua himself did not baptize, but his disciples. He left Judah, and departed again to Galilee, but he needed to go through Samaria. So he came to a city of Samaria, which is called Sychar near the plot of ground that Jacob gave to his son Joseph. Now Jacob's well was there, Yeshua therefor being worried from his journey, sat thus by the well it was about the 6th hour. A woman of Samaria came to draw water. Jesus said to her,

"Give me a drink." For his disciples had gone away into the city to buy food. Then the woman of Samaria said to Him,

"How is it that you being Hebrew ask a drink from me, a Samaritan woman? For Hebrews have no dealings with Samaritans."

Jesus answered and said to her, "If you knew the gift of God and who it is who says to you, 'Give me a drink.' You would have asked him and he would have given you living water. The woman said to him, 'Sir, you have nothing to draw with, and the well is deep. Where then do you get this living water? Are you greater than our father Jacob, who gave us this well and drank from it himself as well as his sons and his livestock?'"

Yeshua answered and said to her, "Whoever drinks of this water will thirst again, but whoever drinks of the water that I shall give will never thirst again, but the water that I shall give to him will become in him a fountain of living water springing up onto everlasting life."

The woman said to Him, "Sir give me this living water that I may not thirst or have to come here to draw."

Yeshua said to her, "Go call your husband to come here."

The woman answered and said, "I have no husband." Jesus said to her, "You have well said, 'I have no husband', for you have had five husbands and the one you now have is not your husband in that you spoke truly."

The woman said to Him, "Sir I perceive that You are a prophet. Our fathers worshiped on this mountain and you Hebrews say that in Jerusalem is the place where one ought to worship."

Yeshua said to her, “Woman believe Me the hour is coming when you will neither on this mountain nor in Jerusalem worship the Father. You worship what you do not know, for salvation is of the Hebrew people. But the hour is coming and now is when the true worshipers will worship the Father in Spirit and truth, for the Father is seeking such to worship Him. God is Spirit and those who worship Him must worship in Spirit and truth.”

The woman said to Him, “I know that Messiah is coming, who is called the Christ. When He comes He will tell us all things.”

Yeshua said to her, “I who speak to you am He.”
