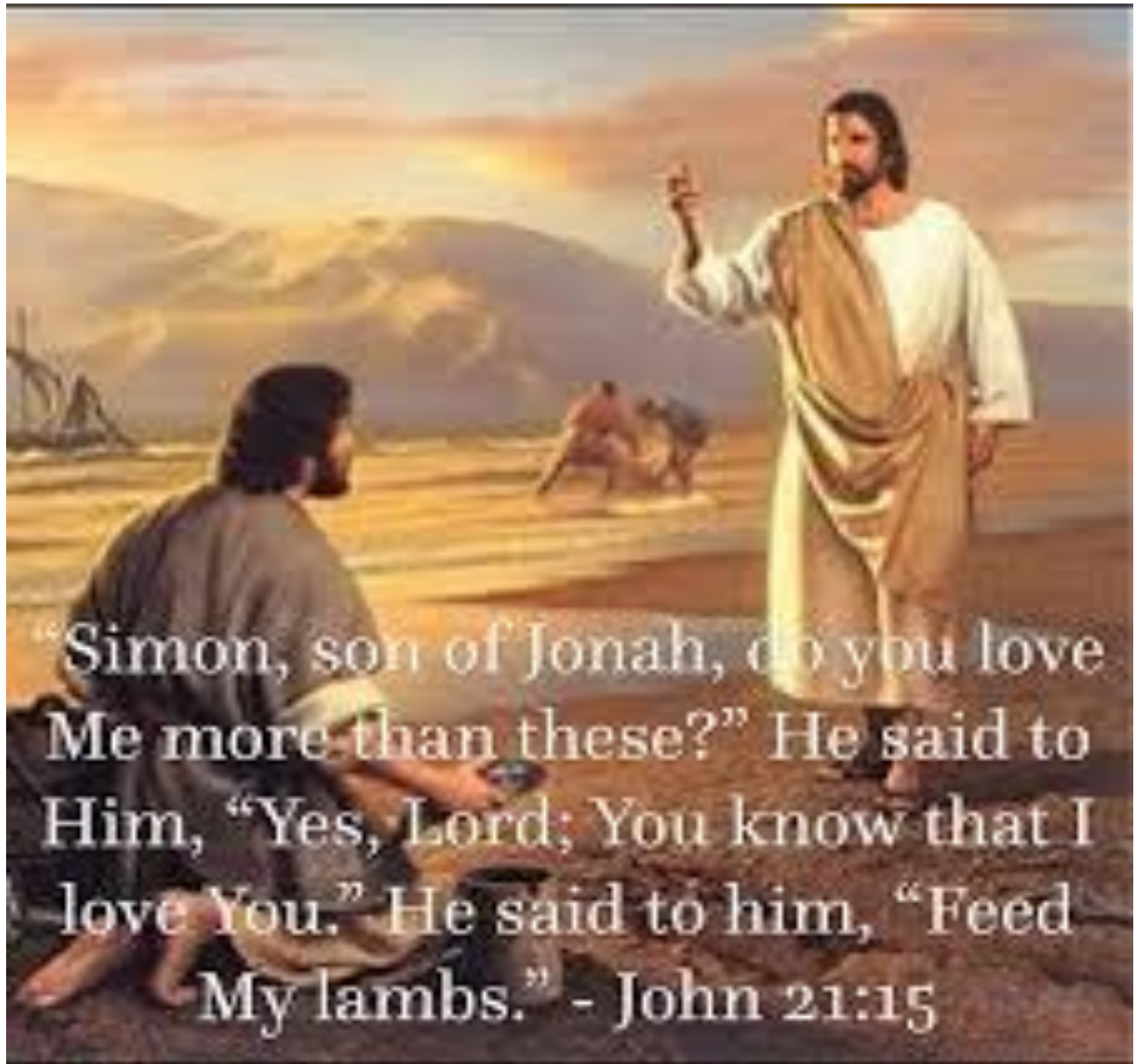


Chaplain America 193 and the Holy Illuminator

The Parable of the Reed and The Oak Tree

The Complete Jewish Study Bible Matthew 11:7

While speaking to the Jewish crowds about Yochanan the Immerser (John the Baptist) Yeshua asks, “what did you go out to the desert to see? Reeds swaying in the breeze?” (Matthew 11:7) There was a well-known parable during the 1st century Jerusalem known as The Reed and The Oak Tree. According to the parable a giant Oak tree and a thin reed were both planted by the river. Whenever a storm came the deep roots of the Oak kept it firmly established enabling it to withstand most winds. It could however be blown over by a wind of significant strength.

There was nothing weak or compromising about the Oak. The reed on the other hand would bend to the right or left even with a slight breeze. the conclusion of the story was that the oak because of its refusal to compromise could end up losing its life in the storm but the reed though it might survive could only do so by continual bending.

Yeshua was clearly pointing to this familiar Jewish story when he essentially asked, “Do you expect John to be a reed blowing in the wind?”

“Did you expect this Prophet of God to be a weak-kneed compromiser?”

The Jewish people who heard this immediately understood what Yeshua was saying and asked no questions.

Matthew 11:7 As they were leaving Yeshua begin speaking about Yochanan to the crowds: “What did you go out to the desert to see? Reeds swaying in the breeze? No? Then what did you go out to see? Someone who was well dressed? Well dressed people live in king’s palaces. But why did you go out? To see a prophet! Yes! and I tell you he's much more than a prophet this is the one about whom the Tanakh says,

‘See I am sending out my messenger ahead of you, he will prepare your way before you.’

Yes, I tell you that among those born of women there has not arisen anyone greater than Yochanan the Immerser! Yet the one who is least in the Kingdom of Heaven is greater than he!"

Pastor Shon and Raphael landed in Israel right in the middle of a war. Hamas was shooting hundreds of rockets across the border from Gaza. The Israelis were defending themselves with the Iron Dome which was made up of an array of anti ballistic missiles that were capable up destroying the incoming missiles in midair.

Pastor Shon could hear the sirens going off throughout the city to warn people of the impending danger, people were running for cover, you could hear sirens and people screaming, Pastor Shon looked at Raphael and said,

"What's the deal here Raphael? Are we going to be Ok?"

"God has got everything in His full control, we are on a mission and He will help us to see it through for His glory. I'll be back in a few days and just like before, chill and be still."

Three days passed and Raphael returned with seven names of the people that Pastor Shon was to anoint for the glory of God and what was really cool Pastor Shon could now speak Hebrew while he was in Israel.

Pastor Shon would say, "Shalom, Yeshua Mashiach loves you and so do I, Baruka Adonai. (Blessed be the Lord)

Then one day a Messianic Rabbi by the name of Herschel came to see Pastor Shon, he said he was sent by God to help in completing Pastor Shon's mission while he was in Israel. Hershel said he was told by God that his son was one of the chosen few to be anointed by Pastor Shon but his son was a devout Jewish believer in the Torah and in the Mosaic law, in fact he was studying to be a Rabbi at the local Synagogue.

The man began telling a fantastic story of how the night before Christ Yeshua visited them in their room and they fell to their knees. The Lord told them that two men would be coming to see them the next day to anoint them and to invite them to give their lives to Him.

Pastor Shon looked at both men and said, "Praise God, Praise God."

Pastor Shon and Rabbi Herschel invited both men to give their lives to the Lord in solemn prayer then Pastor Shon anointed their heads with oil and once again a blinding white light appeared and suddenly Pastor Shon and Rabbi Herschel were back at Pastor Shon's room. Rabbi Herschel looked at Pastor Shon and Raphael who he could now see and said,

“This has surely been a true brakhah today.”

Raphael said he would return soon and to chill. “It’s all good”

Later that same night as the air raid sirens were sounding off and explosions could be heard off in the distance Raphael returned with his next instructions.

“Pastor Shon wake up. I have news, three young children were injured by incoming missiles, one hit just outside their home, the children are on the third floor in critical condition. I have been instructed to take you to them so they can each be anointed with the anointing oil. We are going to do this stealth, no one will be able to see us and as soon as we're finished we'll be back in your room and nobody will know that we had left.”

“Praise God, Praise God, let’s go right away.”

Pastor Shon and Raphael entered the children’s room and Pastor Shon anointed each child and passed a blessing onto their lives and with that the blinding light returned and Pastor Shon and Raphael were back in his room.

In the days that followed the children would have a miraculous recovery, in fact the whole hospital was calling it a flat-out miracle of God. The children were quoting Torah like scholars and they were proclaiming that Yeshua Mashiach had saved their lives. People were crying and praising God and praying and singing, it was absolutely amazing and awesome.

The next day Rabbi Herschel informed Pastor Shon that his son David was brought to the hospital in critical condition after being hurt saving many people at a blast site on route to Jerusalem.

Raphael informed both of them that Herschel’s son was indeed one of the chosen few to be anointed and with that off they went in a flash. Pastor Shon and Rabbi Herschel entered David’s room and knelt bedside, the staff in attendance could only see Rabbi Herschel they could not see Pastor Shon or Raphael.

Pastor Shon and Rabbi Herschel prayed and they both anointed David then suddenly the healing power of God came upon David it was so powerful that the nurses and doctor who were in the room fainted. This time Pastor Shon and Raphael stayed in the room, David regained consciousness and his father told him everything that had happened and right there David had a complete change of

heart, his eyes had become opened for the glory of God, he was now able to recognize Christ Yeshua for Who He truly is. David gave his life to Christ right there on the spot. Rabbi Herschel was so grateful that he looked at Pastor Shon and said, "Where you go I will follow."

Both men looked at Raphael and Raphael smiled and nodded his head yes. Raphael looked at both of them and said,

"We still have one more person to anoint before we leave."

Raphael looked at Pastor Shon and informed him that the seventh person on the anointing list was Rabbi Herschel. Both men teared up and just like that Rabbi Herschel was anointed, illuminated and made a permanent member of the team for the glory of God and off they all went headed for their next destination.

The Seven Anointing Oils

Frankincense and myrrh used for healing and blessings. Myrrh is a burial spice used for those being persecuted and for those who suffer affliction, poverty, and slander.

Oil of Gladness is unscented olive oil used for those in need of comfort for those who mourn, and new beginnings.

Rose of Sharon used for times of rejoicing and great joy.

Lily of the Valley used for repentance and for those who are surrendering their lives in receiving Christ the Lord, it could be also used for those who are recommitting their lives to Christ Yeshua.

Spikenard used as an act of love, praise, and worship in response to forgiveness or in preparation for eternal life.

Latter Rain used to offer hope, encouragement, and incentive to someone needing to stand firm as he or she eagerly awaits the fulfillment of all of the promises of God.

Oil of Pomegranate is in relationship with all the fruits of the Spirit. It is said that a pomegranate has 613 seeds, this is the same number of laws that were given to Moses on Mount Sinai.



2 Kings 9:1-3 And Elisha the prophet called one of the sons of the prophets and said to him, "Get yourself ready, take this flask of oil in your hand and go to Ramoth Gilead. Now when you arrive at the place look there for Jehu the son of Jehoshaphat the son of Nimshi and go in and make him rise up from among his associates and take him to the inner room. Then take the flask of oil and pour it on his head and say,

"Thus says the Lord, I have anointed you king over Israel."

Then open the door and flee and do not delay."

I met Pastor Shon in the spirit world and he told me the whole fantastic story and that his team was now at Kingman Regional Medical Center in Kingman Arizona. I told him that I was planning to go up to Kingman to see Chaplain Basye and Pastor Doug at their Church in Yucca Arizona.
