⁴⁹Jesus stopped and said, "Call him over!"

They called out to the blind man and said, "Don't be afraid! Come on! He is calling for you." ⁵⁰The man threw off his coat as he jumped up and ran to Jesus.

⁵¹Jesus asked, "What do you want me to do for you?"

The blind man answered, "Master,^[b] I want to see!"

⁵²Jesus told him, "You may go. Your eyes are healed because of your faith."

Right away the man could see, and he went down the road with Jesus.

Christ Yeshua healed Bartimaeus by restoring his sight and suddenly this blind beggar someone who was looked at as being worthless and without purpose, someone who must of thought of himself as a total loser, this blind beggar sitting on the side of the road day after day helpless and alone begging for money and food in a blink of an eye became one of the most famous blind beggars in world history. You see years ago my wife and I had medical directives drawn up but in all the rush and confusion of getting to the hospital we had forgotten to bring them.

In the days that followed medical mistakes were made in my case that if my family members had only been allowed to be by my side those mistakes would have been greatly prevented.

Four days later I regained consciousness but I could not speak, I could hear my wife and children telling me that they love and miss me but I could not tell them my concerns about the quality of care I was receiving.

Two weeks went by and finally I began to speak again, I called my wife and told her I loved her, I was able to tell my children I love them too but sadly that's all I was able to do.

I was too weak to tell them about the mistakes that my healthcare providers had made and now an infection caused by a contaminated IV had tragically gone septic and I began to fade away. At some point my family was notified that I might not make it through the night. My wife demanded to be let into the hospital to be by my side but her cries for compassion and love were flatly denied. My children and my wife called the Pastor of our Church, Pastor Wayne Basye and asked him if he could please go to be by my side and administer last rights but he too was flatly denied.

In total desperation my wife placed a call to the hospital Chaplain but his phone went to voice mail so my wife left him a desperate plea, then she gathered my family together, they all held hands in a circle and started to pray,

“O Lord please watch over Daddy, please O Lord help him to get through the night, please Lord help heal our poor father with Your Heavenly Light.”

At 3:00 am I passed away all alone without the love of my family standing by my side because the family I love was forced to stay outside. To the American healthcare providers, Love of family should always come first, to deny patients and their family members visitation and to receive last rites and bedside prayer by Clergy of our choice is immoral and very cruel and inhumane treatment at best.

The autopilot will fly the aircraft safely around the perimeter of the airport until you are ready to land, now don't take to long you don't want to run out of fuel, but you really don't have to worry to much about that because we've got about five hours of fuel aboard this aircraft.

“Well my boy are you ready to take off into the wide blue yonder? Today I'll get us in the air then you can take the controls to get a feel of the aircraft and together we'll bring her back in for a landing, how's that sound?”

“Wow cool let's do this thing”

Well let me just say the first few lessons went great. We flew for about an hour each time and I learned a lot about how to fly. The first two times I flew as co-pilot and on my third time out I flew as pilot with Mr. Henning's help.

Today was to be my 6th and final flight, maybe dad will split the cost for more lessons so I can continue my training.

When we arrived at the airport it began to thunder and rain out, I asked Mr. Henning if we were still going to fly today.

He looked at me with an assuring smile and said, "Well Kevin as a pilot you'll have to learn how to fly in all kinds of weather good and bad, today's a good enough day as any to start learning. Let's climb aboard the aircraft and get in the air.

We took off without a hitch, it was pretty turbulent as we gained altitude then at about 2000 feet things became calm and for the most part smooth.

Then Mr. Henning instructed me to lower our altitude to 500 feet so that I could get more practice in flying in bad weather. We were literally flying through the rain clouds, I could see flashes of lighting and hear the sound of thunder rolling off our backs. Then the wind picked up and I lost control of the aircraft we fell into a dive and rolled at least three times. Mr. Henning took control of the plane and began giving me instructions on what to do. Just as it looked like things were back under control Mr. Henning leaned forward and lost consciousness.

I took control of the plane and tried to revive Mr. Henning but he was out. I checked to see if he was breathing and thank God he was still breathing. Then as I tried to straighten him in his seat and revive him I looked and noticed blood on the back of his head, I then realized he must of hit his head when

we rolled in the dive. I had to think fast, what should I do? I began to panic, I needed to remember what Mr. Henning instructed me to do in a situation like this.

For a moment I prayed and asked for God's guidance and help. Then I remembered call May Day, I turned the radio on and called MAY DAY!!! MAY DAY!!!!!! FLIGHT 193 MAY DAY!!!!!!

The turbulence was fierce, I began to lose control of aircraft then a still small voice within said turn on the autopilot Kevin. I reached over and switched to autopilot then the plane leveled out and even though there was still some turbulence I felt a lot safer. Just then a voice came over the air waves that said,

“We roger that what is the nature of your emergency Cessna 193?”

I began to explain my situation to the people in the control tower. Now I was calm I knew I was in good hands, the instructor on the ground gave me excellent instructions on how to land the aircraft and the autopilot gave me peace of mind, I could function with more confidence in knowing I was in good hands.

O by the way I landed just fine and Mr. Henning well he had a nice big bump on his head and when he got out of the hospital he told me that I pass flight school and that the rest of the lessons are his present free of charge.

Just one thing though I thank God for helping me get home safely and healing Mr. Henning in Yeshua's name Amen...

O and Mom well she doesn't need to know about what happened so please don't tell her or I'll never hear the end of it, trust me I'll never be able to fly again let alone set foot in an airport alone ever again either.

When the storms of life come crashing in all around us we tend to try to weather the storm out ourselves under our own strength and will by flying straight through the darkened clouds. All too often we place God in the back seat of life letting Him only take full control when we are literally inches away from crashing.

Our walk with Christ Yeshua is the same way when we try to do it our way we crash and burn-out.

By trying to live up to our own view of what a Christian is we become filled with anxiety, fear, worry, doubt and depression. We tend to want to serve many hours thinking that that is what's expected of us.

But in all reality, He is the Pilot of our lives and when we switch over in faith to Autopilot and let go and let God be in full control, all the worry, doubt, fear, anxiety, anger and depression suddenly begins to fade away until what is left is the peace of God which surpasses all understanding.

We are at peace in knowing that God is real and is in full control of our lives, for He is faithful to lead us onward toward a safe landing in eternity.

If you feel like your life is spinning out of control maybe it's time to switch over to Autopilot and let God lead the way to a more meaningful life in Christ Yeshua...
